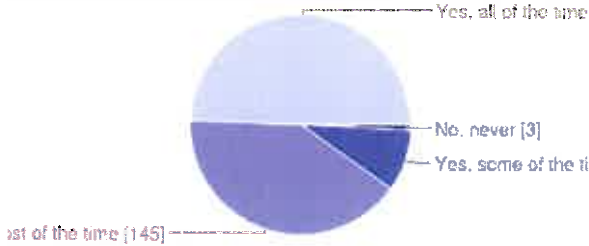

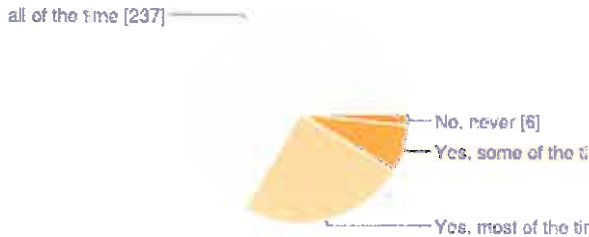

### Do you feel safe while you are at school?



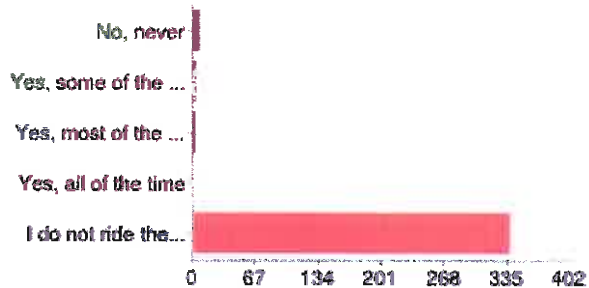

### Do you feel safe on your way to and from school?



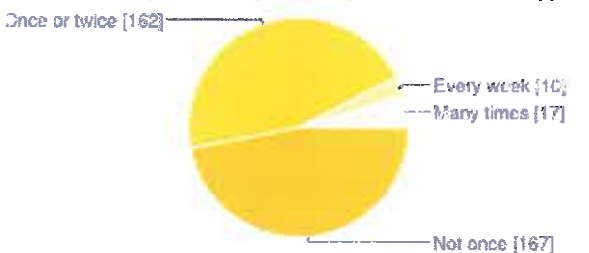

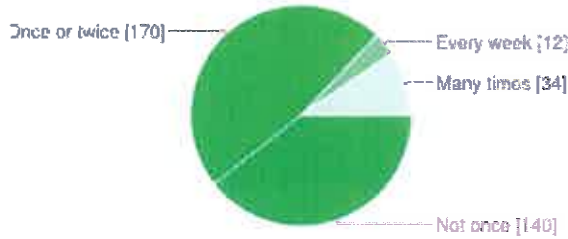

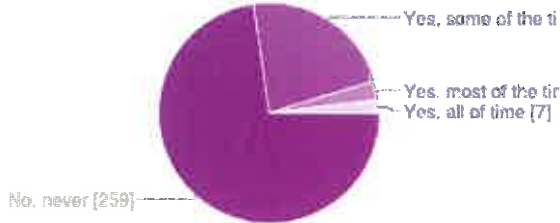

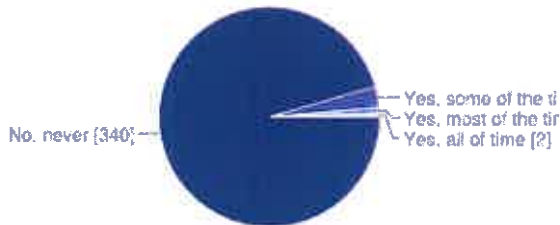

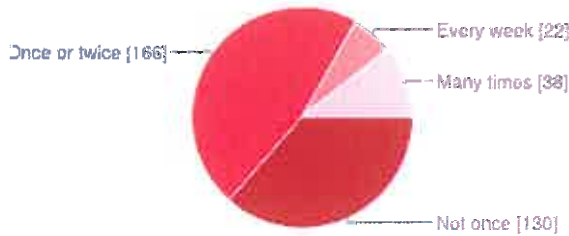

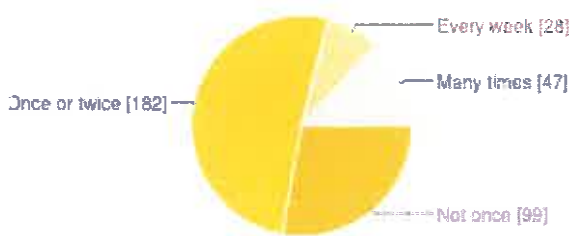

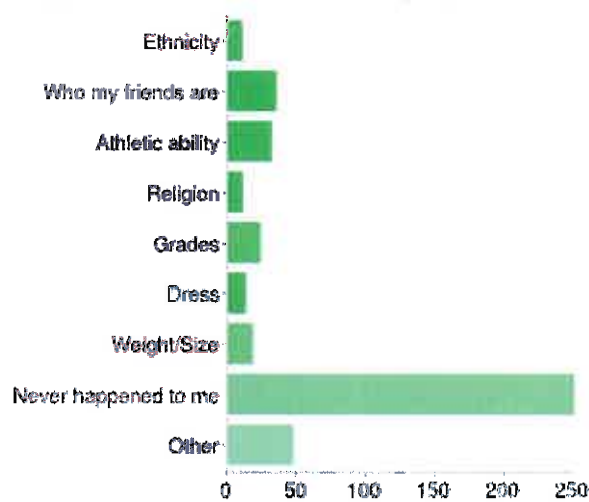

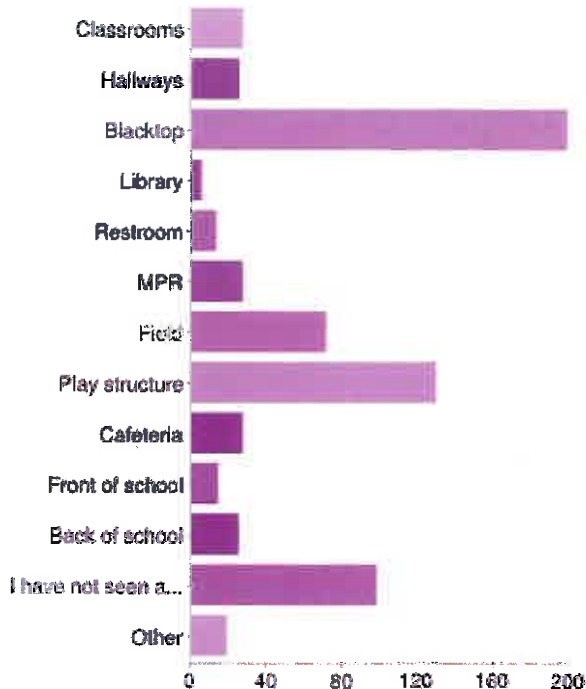

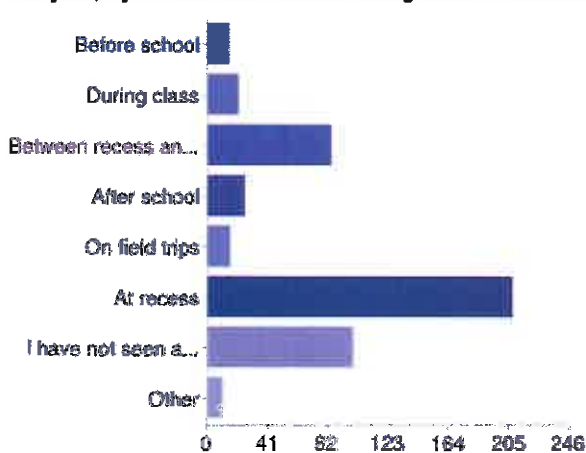

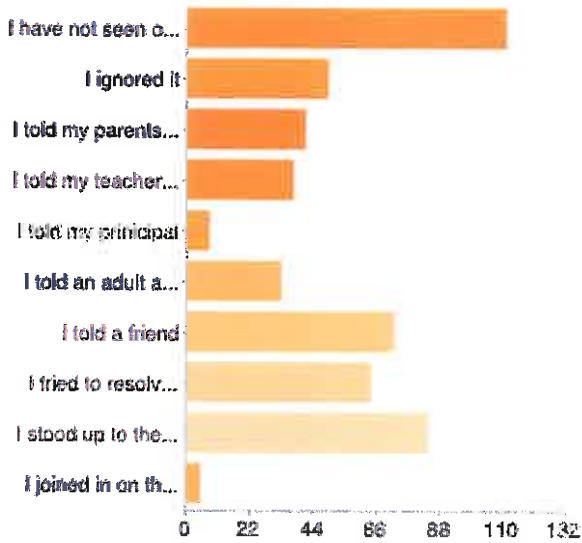

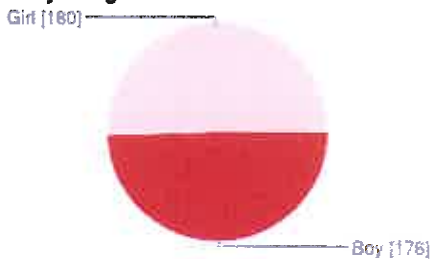
**How can students help prevent bullying or exclusion at school?**

They can walk up to them or tell a peacemaker. 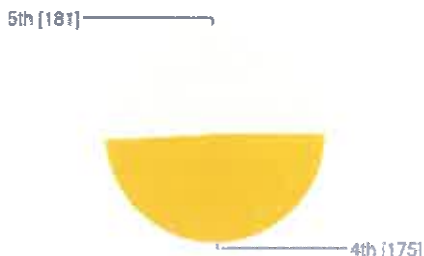

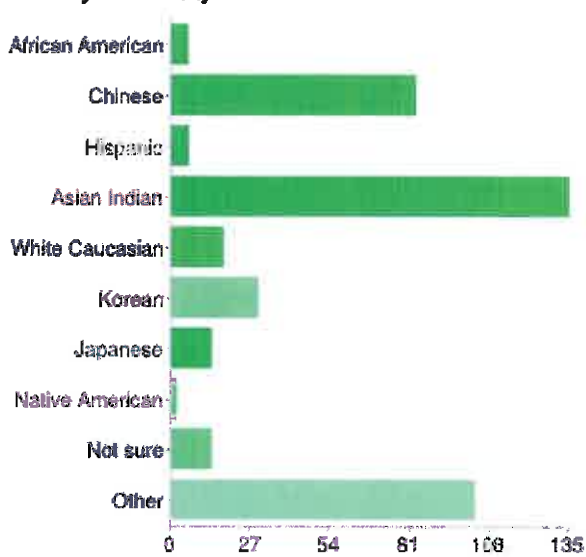
